Eagle Scout Wesley Eskridge has led his team to construct one of two bridges to aid the mountain bike trail system here at Grand Vue Park. The second bridge will be completed in the first or second week of June and the bridge will also help the disc golf community on their up and coming White Course. The group finished the first bridge in one day from start to finish. For those attempting the Golf Course Trail you will encounter both

of Wesley's bridges. Both of them are etched with the Troop 79-Eagle Scout-Wesley Eskridge. The installation of these bridges will also benefit the scouts with their hikes, the mountain bike community, the disc golf community, and the Army Nation Guard on their 20 mile hikes. With the completion of the second bridge will allow Grand Vue Park to offer 21 miles of hiking and biking trails. A big thanks to Wesley and his volunteers for a job well done.



Activity of the WVU GIS Technical Center Rejuvenates Park Map



We are very excited about our upgrades to the park's new map. David Donaldson from the West Virginia University GIS Technical Center led his team to collect the new data of the trail system created by Todd Hager the Park's trail builder. We now have the new maps in our info boxes in the park at 4 of our trailhead boxes. The park now has 4 trails total; the 15 mile mountain bike trail (orange), the 4 mile walking trail (yellow), the 2 mile walking trail (blue), and a new .5 mile

hiking only trail called the Rock Cliff Trail (green). The trails are also available on your smart phone by searching the West Virginia Trail Inventory in your web browser. Make sure your location services are on and tap the "find my location" icon once in the park. You will be able to navigate the trails at the park and not to mention all of the trails in West Virginia. New maps will be available in the main office for park goers to pick up and check out the 21 miles of trails at the park!
