New Trail Signs to be Built and Installed by Troop 79



New things are happening out on the trails at Grand Vue Park. Troop 79 will be building and designing trail signs for the mountain bike trail system. The signs will have trail names, direction and difficulty ratings for users to determine where they are in the park and how difficult the designated section is. We are working

on marking our beginner loop which is suitable for entry level mountain bikers and families who want to enjoy a ride off of the pavement. The beginner loop is roughly 5 to 6 miles of both single and double track. The new signs will display color coded symbols for different loops as well to accommodate all riders.
