

GRAND VUE PARK GIVES BACK

The Marshall County Park and Recreation Board, DBA Grand Vue Park donated a playground to the City of Cameron to be installed at the Cameron Recreation Park. This playground was won by the staff at Grand Vue Park at the West Virginia Recreation and Park Association Conference held in Bridgeport, WV on September 19 – 21, 2023. There will be no cost to the city- the playground, the border, the mulch and the installation of all of this is included.

At the Conference, Cunningham Recreation donated a turnkey playground to the conference organizers to be given away during the event. It was decided prior to the event that if Grand Vue Park's staff won the playground it would be donated to another location in Marshall County. When one of our tickets was pulled, we were very excited, and the search began for where this playground would make the most impact. After driving all over the County and looking at a variety of locations we liked the Cameron Recreation Park for two reasons. First, on how clean the park was kept and second that there is no playground.



So, on behalf of the Marshall County Park and Recreation Board, Grand Vue Park Staff, the Marshall County Commission and Cunningham Recreation we are happy to donate this playground to the City of Cameron to be placed at the Cameron Recreation Park. We hope that this will make a positive impact on the quality of life for the residents of Cameron, WV.


