



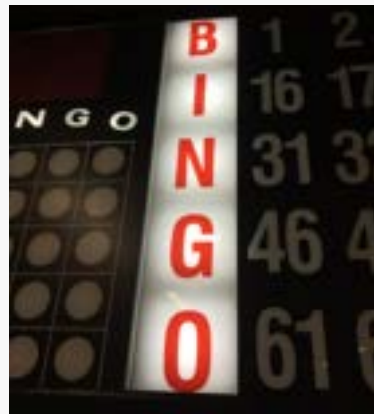
## WELCOME TO GRAND VUE PARK!

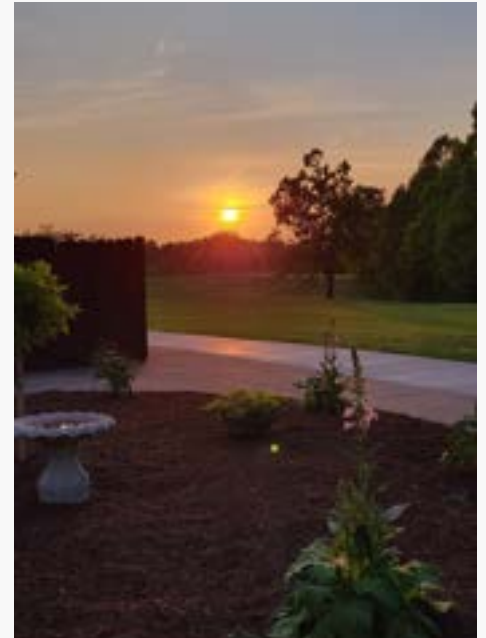

## WHATS NEXT FOR THE PARK?

### GRAND VUE PARK POOL PROGRESS

The Grand Vue Park pool has 12 lifeguards eager to get the season started and are helping prepare the pool until we get the “all clear” sign from the contractors! The pool will consist of basketball hoops, 2 water walks, a lap swimming area, a 9ft climbing wall, diving board, 2 slides, one open and one closed, and splash features in the beach entry section of the pool. The depth at the deep end of the pool is 11’ 6” to 4’ in the lap swimming area, the rest of the pool ranges from zero entry to 3’6”. This pool is handicap accessible with two lifts to assist swimmers to get into the pool.

The hours of operation are going to be 12pm – 7pm, however, we will be opening with one lifeguard at 11am for lap swimming only. The beach area will have 3 large shade structures, 90 lounge chairs and 15 tables with 4 chairs and an umbrella per table. Pool parties will be a little different with this pool. We will have two options with two timeslots for each location. We will be able to utilize Richmond Hall except for Saturdays and we hope to have the shelter at the pool completed soon after we open. The Grand Vue Park pool is opening soon! We have made a huge amount of progress over the past few months and continue to make progress as we finish up construction. The Grand Vue Park Board and staff have spent the past few weeks working on pool rates, all while keeping our Marshall County residents in mind. Highlights from the pricing include the Marshall County resident season pass, which averages out to 15 visits to the pool! The rates will be prorated once we determine an opening date.

We want to thank the Marshall County Commission for their assistance with the financing of this new attraction to Marshall County! This water park is sure to be a destination as well as benefit our Marshall County Community.

# NEW ADDITIONS TO GRAND VUE PARK

## TREE PLANTING AT GRAND VUE PARK

Grand Vue Park held a "Plant More Trees Event" where families, groups or organizations could come to the park to plant a tree for free. The Marshall County Co-Op sponsored the event by donating funds for 30 trees and protective fencing and poles to keep them safe from wildlife. There were 9 different groups who took advantage of the planting opportunity. The trees for this event were planted below the banquet hall and along the beginning of the walking trail.



April and May were all about planting more trees! During the past two months over 160 trees have been planted throughout Grand Vue Park! The Cameron Future Farmers of America and the Marshall County Co-Op were the two major contributors to the initiative. Cameron FFA donated and planted 130 saplings. The group concentrated on planting where there is significant damage from the Emerald Ash Borer. The EAB larvae kill ash trees by tunneling under the bark and feeding on the part of the tree that moves water and sugars up and down the trunk. There are areas of the park that are completely devastated from this action.



Cameron Future Farmers of America, The Marshall County Co-Op, and the volunteers in the Plant More Trees program stepped up for the future of the park and we cannot thank them enough!
