During the past month, several members of Grand Vue's management team attended the West Virginia Recreation Parks Association conference in Canaan Valley. This event provided an opportunity for management to network and engage with peers from various parks within similar fields.





While at the WVRPA conference, Grand Vue Park received the Austin C. Palmer Award for Outstanding facilities serving a large segment of a geographic area that are aesthetically pleasing, evidence of sound design, programmed to maximum potential and in operation for at least one year.

Trishell received the Richard P. Sebastian Leadership Award for being under 30 years of age and exhibiting qualities of ambition, creativity, dedication to the recreation profession and be cooperative, hardworking and loyal in nature.



GRAND VUE PARK & MARSHALL COUNTY SHUTTLE

Marshall County has a shuttle service for guests staying at Grand Vue Park, Palace of Gold, Marshall County hotels and motels. Guests are welcome to use the shuttle to travel to and from Marshall County attractions during operating hours.

The shuttle service is free during the week from 10 am - 5pm. There is also the 2-hour Marshall County Tour. This includes iconic stops throughout the county and their historical backgrounds. This tour is \$25/person, and guests can pay the day of but must call 24hrs in advance. Tours are limited to 14 people at a time and includes a cup of ice cream at Flurrys Ice Cream Shop.
