REBRANDING GRAND VUE PARK

The Marshall County Park & Recreation Board, in collaboration with the professional team at Grand Vue Park, engaged in a four-month partnership with New South Media during the recent spring season to rebrand Grand Vue. The primary objective was to modernize the park's logo while preserving its essence as a picturesque hilltop destination in Marshall County, West Virginia. The revamped logo introduces fresh colors, a nod to the blue hues reminiscent of the 1970s logo, a clean and easily legible font, an adaptable icon intended for standalone use, and three versions: one featuring Marshall County, WV; another showcasing the slogan "Celebrate, Play, Escape"; and a third with the slogan "Reach New Heights," alongside a version with no slogan.









The unveiling of the new logo is scheduled to unfold gradually over the coming months through email communications, social media platforms, and promotional merchandise. Melissa is overseeing sales of merchandise in the General Store, including vintage 50th-anniversary sweatshirts, t-shirts, and more featuring the previous logo. As we celebrate the achievements of the past 50 years, we eagerly anticipate the journey ahead into the next half-century.

LANDSCAPING TIPS WITH CODY

As September rolls around in northern West Virginia, the landscape begins to transition from the lush greens of summer to the vibrant hues of autumn. This is the perfect time to prepare your garden for the cooler months ahead. One of the standout plants for the season is chrysanthemum, commonly known as mums. Here are some detailed landscaping tips to help you make the most of your garden and flower beds in September.



First and foremost, it's important to clean up your garden by removing any dead or diseased plants. This not only keeps your garden and flower beds looking tidy but also prevents the spread of disease to healthy plants. Additionally, consider trimming back any perennials that have finished blooming. This will encourage new growth and help them prepare for the winter months. As the temperatures start to drop, it's also a good time to mulch your flower beds. Mulching helps to retain moisture, regulate soil temperature, and suppress weeds.



When it comes to planting mums, September is an ideal time. Mums are hardy flowers that can withstand the cooler temperatures of autumn and add a burst of color to your garden. To plant mums, choose a sunny spot with well-drained soil. Dig a hole that is slightly larger than the root ball of the plant and place the mum in the hole, making sure the top of the root ball is level with the soil surface. Fill in the hole with soil and water thoroughly. Mums benefit from regular watering, especially during dry spells, but be careful not to overwater as this can lead to root rot.

In addition to mums, consider planting other fall blooming flowers such as asters, sedum, and ornamental grasses. These plants not only add visual interest to your garden but also provide food and habitat for pollinators. As you plant, remember to space your plants appropriately to allow for air circulation and growth. This will help prevent disease and ensure your plants have enough room to thrive!
